Re: State Senate election

Although the 2016 election will be a big one nationally, here in Illinois, the only statewide election will be for State Comptroller.

The contests to watch will be the 40 State Senate Districts that will be up for election. Some will be for 4-year terms and some for 2-year terms. Currently, there are 39 Democrats and 20 Republicans. Although a few Democrats may lose, John Cullerton and the Democrats will remain in control. It will also be the first test of Governor Rauner's skills and his resources.

Obviously, large amounts of money will be expended and campaign rhetoric will be pervasive. The roster of the incumbents are below.

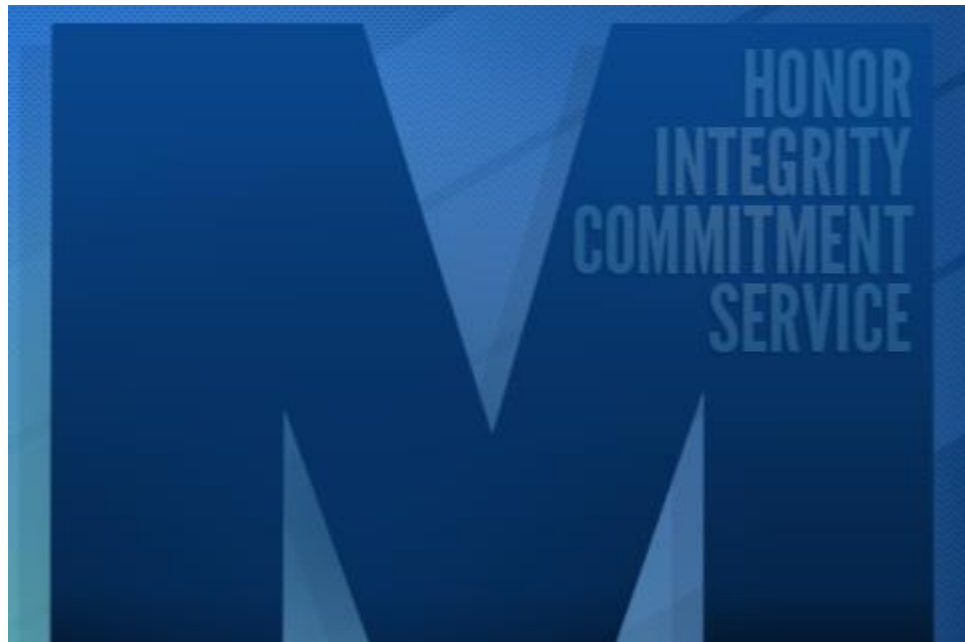
